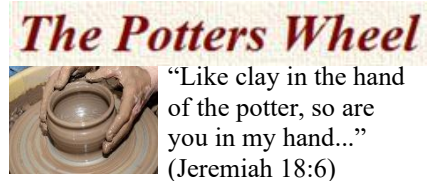

What a wonderful day of worship this past Sunday as we remembered those who gave their lives so we could enjoy the freedom of worshipping our Lord and celebrating the baptism of Harper Lindsey together as a church family

Let me take a few minutes in this article to share a reminder of a trip down the Roman Road that everyone needs to make.

1. The Problem is All Have Sinned. We need to understand our need for a Savior. That path begins by establishing that every person falls short of God's standard. Romans 3:23 "For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God."
2. The Consequence is that Sin Leads to Death. Remember that there is a penalty for sin and that our actions separate us from a holy God and result in spiritual death. Romans 6:23 "For the wages of sin is death...."
3. The Solution is God's Gift of Love to the World. Even despite our human imperfections, God has provided a way out. This step reveals that Jesus Christ paid the ultimate penalty for our sins. Romans 5:8 "But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us."
4. The Result is Eternal Life. When we return to the earlier concept of wages, this verse pivots to show that salvation is an earned gift of grace. Romans 6:23 "... but the gift is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord."
5. The Response is Faith and Confession. The path concludes by explaining how a person accepts this gift through genuine belief and by publicly acknowledging Jesus as Lord. Romans 10:9 "If you declare with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved." Romans 10:13 "For, everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved."

Maybe you can travel down this road and recall your own experience with our Lord. Or better yet, why don't you share your travels down the Roman Road with someone who needs Christ in their heart.
